

Food Truck Hire Policy

Updated September 2025

1. Purpose

This policy outlines the terms and conditions for the operation of a food truck in the car parks of Steeple Aston Village Hall and Sports & Recreation Centre, Fir Lane, Steeple Aston. This applies to all food truck operators seeking to operate for commercial food service.

2. Operating Hours

- Standard operating hours: **8am to 12 midnight** unless otherwise agreed.
- No overnight stays or storage of vehicles.

3. Site Rules

- Permission is limited to one vehicle, or vehicle plus trailer no larger than a Luton van.
- No obstruction of emergency exits or disabled bays.
- Noise levels must be kept to a minimum.
- All waste must be removed from site at the end of service and disposed of responsibly—no littering or oil discharge.
- No alcohol sales unless licensed.

4. Insurance & Liability

- The food truck operator is responsible for any damage to property or injury caused during the hire period.
- Steeple Aston Parish Council accepts no liability for loss, theft, or damage to the food truck or its contents.

5. Termination & Cancellation

- The car park owner reserves the right to cancel or terminate the hire at any time due to breach of policy, safety concerns, or unforeseen circumstances.

6. Indemnity

- The operator agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the car park owner from any claims, damages, or legal actions arising from the food truck's operation.
